

Leading women's giving circle network announces its 2020-21 Board of Directors July 22, 2020

Philanos, the leading women's giving circle network in the U.S., announces its Board of Directors for 2020-2021 comprised of women who are members of Philanos affiliate organizations.

Philanos' mission is to support the creation, development, and expansion of women's collective giving grantmaking nationwide. For a decade, Philanos has led a network of women's collective giving groups, sometimes referred to as giving circles, which help women aggregate their money to make high-impact grants in their local communities. Started in 2010 as WCGN (Women's Collective Giving Grantmakers Network), the organization currently has over 70 affiliates in the US, Australia and England, representing \$140 million in granting by more than 17,500 women since 1995.
